- On the ballot for the General Election in November, you will be asked:

“Shall the state constitution be amended to repeal the legislature’s authority to reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples?”

- THIS DOES NOT REPEAL SAME-SEX MARRIAGE.
- THIS TAKES AWAY THE LEGISLATURE’S AUTHORITY TO LIMIT MARRIAGE TO OPPOSITE-SEX COUPLES.
- This authority is discriminatory and we are working to strike it from the State Constitution.
- Across the country, LGBTQ+ rights are under assault by conservative organizations and politicians. This 26-year old language keeps open the door for such entities to repeal the right to same-sex marriage in Hawai‘i.
- We want to take steps now to protect the right to same-sex marriage in Hawai‘i.
- Amendments to the Constitution require a high threshold for passage: BLANK VOTES ARE EQUIVALENT TO “NO” VOTES. This means we need the “YES” votes to equal a MAJORITY OF ALL BALLOTS CAST in the November General Election.
- Nevada took this step of a State Constitutional Amendment several years ago. And California, Colorado, and other states are looking to do the same this year. Join us!
